# LRR (ListeningReading Responses)

#### **Types of LRR Entries:**

- 1. Opinion: what you think or feel
- 2. Question: specific/general
- 3. Connection: what story/ poem/ incident is related?
- 4. Themes/Topics: Identify main & sub themes/topics/plot etc.



The FIVE (3S2T) senses we use in Observation are:

Sight (eyes)

Sound (ears)

Smell (nose)

**T**aste (tongue)
